Equipment

Students must provide their own laptop or similar device for classroom use. PLEASE note a Chrome Book is not compatible with our system

Students must have a smartphone and a New Zealand sim card. This can be organised on arrival in NZ.

Students need to bring/buy their own black leather school shoes. Sneakers are not acceptable.

Insurance

International students must have appropriate and current medical and travel insurance to meet Code of Practice and Immigration requirements while in New Zealand. Uni-Care Travel and Medical Insurance may be arranged through our school. Cost depends on the length of stay. Please enquire for an estimate. We highly recommend the purchase of the insurance through the school as coverage is excellent for NZ and making any claims is easier.

Uniform Hire

Uniform hire includes 3 shirts, 2 pairs of trousers, school tie, jersey and a jacket (weather-proof).

Students need to bring their own black leather shoes and buy at least 3 pairs of school socks for NZ\$18 (2022 prices). If a student wants a school blazer, they will need to purchase this separately.

The blazer is not compulsory for short term students (Cost @2022 price \$150)
